ITEMS OF GENERAL DISCUSSION:

- 1. The Committee reviewed 2022 Minutes.
- 2. The Committee discussed the 2023 state series
 - a. The Committee talked about the excess gear brought into the pit area at girls state. Stacey is going to work to remind coaches that with the limited space available in the pit area to leave unnecessary equipment in the paddock.
 - b. The Committee talked about new or first-time coaches coming to state and maybe not being aware of the procedures with picking up wrist bands and knowing the oil pattern is a house shot. Stacey is going to put additional information into the coach's information that is sent out prior to the event.
 - c. The Committee talked about the crowding in the pit area when two groups of individuals are on a pair of lanes together. They're not sure it can be 100% prevented but Stacey is going to review the lane assignments to see what's possible.
 - d. The Committee talked about new or first-time hosts not being aware of the regional/sectional schedule (ie. Warmup time, lunch time, etc). The Committee felt it would also be helpful to provide ideas for the coaches meeting at regionals and sectionals.
