

DIRECTIONS & SUBMITTING WORK

Photographers will submit a series of three photos with a common theme to collectively tell a story. Photoshop can be used to enhance the images but not alter the content. The submission must include a brief written summary to provide context for the photo story, although the written portion will not factor into your judging rank.

Naming Convention: Name your photos Photo 1, Photo 2 and Photo 3. Your folder will be named with your four-digit school code.

Sizing of Photos: Whether the submitted photo is horizontal or vertical, the widest side should be saved at 1500 pixels, with a resolution no greater than 100.

Timeline: You may begin shooting photos 9:00 AM and must have your work edited and available for judges to begin judging at 1:00 PM.

Judging: When you are finished with your work, access the Google Drive on this page: www.ihsa.org/Journalism-State-Series and click "Submit Work" in the Photo Story Telling column. This will take you to a Google Drive with folders labeled by four-digit school codes. Find your code and drop your three photos in the folder.

ASSIGNMENT

The subject of the photography competition is "A Day In The Life at Heartland Community College". Document events and life on campus using your three photos that collectively tell a story of your choosing. It could be related to people, events, architecture, the campus, etc. You may take photos anywhere on campus unless you are told otherwise by tournament managers or school personnel. Include a written statement to explain your story. The written portion will give the judges context, but will not factor into your ranking. Photos can be color or black-and-white.
