Warm-up times in the field events: Pole Vault 30 minutes per flight; Discus 20 minutes per flight; Shot Put 15 minutes per flight; Long Jump 15 minutes per flight; High Jump 15 minutes per flight; Triple Jump 15 minutes per flight.

Pole Vault Weigh-in: Semis—Contestants by flight order in the tent at the southeast corner of O'Brien Stadium beginning with all **1A Flights** weighing in from 10:00 a.m. until 11:00 a.m. Competitors will be weighed in flight order. Once a flight has been weighed, those in the next flight will be weighed. If there is a break in the weigh-in, competitors may check their weight with the permission of the judges.

Packet Pick-Up, Thursday—All Classes may pick up their team packets between 8:00 a.m. and 7:00 p.m. on the main level at the Lantz Building.

Shot Inspection: Shots will be weighed and measured at the tent in the northeast corner of the stadium.

Discus Inspection: Discus will be weighed and measured at the tent located at the discus rings south of the stadium.
