## IMPORTANT HIGH JUMP NOTICE 2007 STATE FINALS

Sectional hosts and/or Meet Referees, please share this information with all schools at the sectional seed meetings.

This information explains the seeding process for the State Finals in the High Jump and the Pole Vault.

Please note in the 2006-07 Track and Field Terms and Conditions item VIII-M-2 (Special State Meet Provisions).

The process described in section 2 (gray box, page 13) is not accurate. We will continue to use the process used in the past for both the High Jump and the Pole Vault. The process for seeding these events at the State Meets is described below.

For Friday's prelims the flights are organized to have the top qualifiers in the first flight. Within each flight competitors are ranked from the lowest sectional marks to the best sectional marks.

Those competitors that qualify for Saturday's finals are first ordered from worst to best by their performance in Friday's prelims. Then the procedure is ran and the athletes with the same prelim marks are ordered from worst to best based on their sectional seed mark, within the order of their prelim mark. Here is an example:

Seed Marks from Sectionals:

A 5'02"  
B 5'04"  
C 5'06"  
D 5'08"

Friday Prelim Mark:

A 5'06"  
B 5'06"  
C 5'04"  
D 5'06"

Saturday Final Order will be:

C 5'04" 5'06"  
A 5'06" 5'02"  
B 5'06" 5'04"  
D 5'06" 5'08"
