Coaches Notes: Just a couple of things to point out prior to Saturdays tournament.

- The launching of boats went really smooth and you all did a great job parking. Please make sure we keep all cars without trailers off the trailer lot and all buses in the storage lot north of the launch.
- When boats arrive to the launch you can pay at the parking shack and launch immediately. After putting in the water you can come back to the tent and register.
- We will be going out in reverse order starting with boat 36 and going to 1.
- **Important note**: For boats fishing in the April 19 tournament who **did not fish** in the April 12th tournament We randomly drew boat numbers 37-46 for you and assigned them to your boat. You will go out in that order after boat 1 is released.
- We will keep boat numbers for the tournament on May 3 but will re-draw release order.
- We will post a running points total after each tournament to see where schools stand with angler of the year. Top 15 schools, based on points, will make it to the Classic tournament on May 17!
