

## IHSA BOWLING SECTIONAL ROTATIONS FOR OPEN LANES

### 18 Lane Rotations with 17 Teams

In a sectional that competes on 18 lanes but has only 17 teams, a slight change in the rotation will be used to prevent a team from bowling in an open lane twice during the sectional tournament. The change is as follows:

In the afternoon round for game 4 only, the teams in the **even** lanes will move 3 sets of lanes to their right rather than 1 set of lanes. Teams on the odd lanes will not move any differently. That means teams on the odd lanes will move 1 set of lanes to the left after each game.

### 16 Lane Rotations with 15 Teams

In a sectional that competes on 16 lanes but has only 15 teams, a slight change in the rotation will be used to prevent a team from bowling in an open lane twice during the sectional tournament. The change is as follows:

In the afternoon round for game 4 only, the teams in the **even** lanes will move **2** sets of lanes to their right rather than 1 set of lanes. Teams on the odd lanes will not move any differently. That means teams on the odd lanes will move 1 set of lanes to the left after each game.

### 12 Lane Rotations with 11 Teams

In a sectional that competes on 12 lanes but has only 11 teams, a slight change in the rotation will be used to prevent a team from bowling in an open lane twice during the sectional tournament. The change is as follows:

In the afternoon round for game 4 only, the teams in the **even** lanes will move **2** sets of lanes to their right rather than 1 set of lanes. Teams on the odd lanes will not move any differently. That means teams on the odd lanes will move 1 set of lanes to the left after each game.

### 14 Lane Rotations with 13 Teams

In a sectional that competes on 14 lanes but has only 13 teams, **no change is needed to this rotation**. Teams will still rotate one pair of lanes right and/or left.
