

# **A Bill to Fund STEM**

# **201**

1 BE IT ENACTED BY THE CONGRESS HERE ASSEMBLED THAT:

2 **SECTION 1.** The United States Federal Government shall provide tax incentives to any  
3 business that will provide expert instructors for the purpose of STEM education.

4 **SECTION 2.** Tax incentives are defined as credit given to businesses that fulfill the necessary  
5 requirements and promote STEM education. Expert instructors are defined as  
6 professionals knowledgeable in a specific field of study. STEM is defined as  
7 education programs that emphasize Science, Technology, Engineering, and  
8 Mathematics.

9 **SECTION 4.** This bill shall be enforced by the Internal Revenue Service (IRS) in consultation  
10 with the Department of Education.

11 **SECTION 3.** This law will take effect within six months of passage.

12 **SECTION 5.** All laws in conflict with this legislation are hereby declared null and void.
