If an eligibility ruling regarding residence is requested, this form must be completed and sent to the Executive Director for a ruling. Refer to the by-law reference listed with each item to decide if a ruling by the Executive Director is to be requested. REMINDER: In accordance with the IHSA Constitution, only the IHSA's Executive Director may issue an official ruling.
