

## Certified Body Fat Assessors

All IHSA Body Fat Assessors certified prior to the Fall of 2015, and all brand-new Body Fat Assessors, are required to attend a body fat training course to learn new methods of testing wrestlers' body fat. Body Fat Assessors who have attended a class since the Fall of 2015 have been trained on the new protocol. They do not need to attend another "live" body fat training course for four years from the date they attended the class, but they must recertify through the Officials Center and complete the online course between "live" courses.

Classes for the Fall of 2018 are listed below. We will offer more classes in the Fall of 2019.

**Note:** Spring classes will no longer be available.

Current Body Fat Assessors who have not taken the "live" class between 2015 and the Fall of 2018 will be put on IHSA probation for one year.

Body Fat Assessors on IHSA probation who do not take the "live" class by the Fall of 2019 will be suspended and will no longer be able to perform body fat tests on wrestlers.
