The Receiving School must determine whether the student complies with all IHSA eligibility by-laws. The Receiving School shall a) advise the student of its determination or b) request a ruling from the Executive Director. The Principals' Concurrence Regarding Transfer and the Transfer Eligibility Form must be submitted to the IHSA Office, along with all relevant documentation, if a ruling is requested. The IHSA reserves the right to investigate any transfer and make a ruling on the student's eligibility regardless of concurrence by the principals or determination by the Receiving School. **REMINDER: In accordance with the IHSA Constitution, only the IHSA's Executive Director may issue an official ruling.**

Principals are held responsible for including correct and accurate information on the form and for the accurate completion of the form.
