TABLE 1-7: TABLE OF STATE ASSOCIATION ADOPTIONS

- 1. Designate the field dimensions as official.
 - o Diagram #3
- 2. Determine the number of game officials.
 - o **2-person** Referee & Field Judge
 - o **3-person** Referee (R), Field Judge (FJ), Side Judge (SJ)
 - o **4-person** Referee (R), Field Judge (FJ), Back Judge (BJ), Side Judge (SJ)
 - **Regionals** 3 Officials
 - o **Sectionals and State** 4 Officials
- 3. Determine the time for game officials to assume authority if greater than 30 minutes.
 - o 30 minutes
- 4. Approve alteration of the team box if the same for both teams.
 - With limited exceptions, nonplayers are not permitted in the restricted area at any time during the game. Nonplayers include coaches, team personnel, spectators, game administrators, and members of the media.
- 5. Authorize the use of goals.
 - No goals
- 6. Mandate the use of a specific ball for postseason or playoff competition.
 - All IHSA State Series games will be played with the Wilson GST SPEEDSKIN HEIR
 - o For non-state series games, any ball meeting NFHS 1-3-1 is acceptable.
- 7. Authorize the use of a kicking tee.
 - o No
- 8. **Auth**orize the use of supplementary equipment to aid in game administration.
 - o No
- 9. Authorize the wearing of a commemorative/memorial patch.
 - Yes-Allowed

10. Determine the style of flag used and flag measurements (may not be below minimum).

 Pop flag belts must be worn during all contests with two (2) pop-up flags. (You MUST bring your own belts)

Flag Dimensions:

- All flags must be at least 15.5 inches long and 1.5 inches wide
- Flags **CANNOT** match the color of the players' shorts and must be a single solid color (manufacturer's trademark is allowed)
- If the shorts have a stripe, the flags **CANNOT** be the same color as the stripe or shorts
- Excess flag belt must be tucked into the shorts or secured with a manufactured belt loop or tape
- Flags must be placed one on each hip

11. Authorize the use of a drum for rhythmic cadence for deaf or partially deaf teams.

Yes (1-6-1 NOTE)

12. Authorize the use of hash marks.

o CPS plays on a number of grass fields. Clinicians and Advisory believe this adoption could be 1 year away.

13. Establish a procedure to resolve games tied following the fourth period.

- **Overtime Procedure:**
 - Overtime will occur if the score is tied at the end of regulation.
 - A coin toss is held before overtime; the visiting team calls the toss.
 - Toss winner chooses either:
 - Offense or defense first
 - Which end zone the OT is played
 - Both teams will get a single extra point attempt:
 - 1 point from the 3-yard line
 - 2 points from the **10-yard line**
 - Interceptions end the down (no return for points)
 - The order of offense and defense flips with each OT period
 - Each team gets **1 timeout per overtime period** (non-cumulative)

14. Establish a point differential to terminate games or use a running clock.

- o Mercy Rule:
 - 35+ points or more in the 3rd or 4th quarter- running clock
 - Once the 35 point spread is reached the clock will run and will not return to the timing in the 1st and 2nd quarter.
 - Clock only stops on scores, timeouts, quarter changes, and injuries during the Mercy Rule

15. Establish rules regarding continuation of interrupted games.

- Postseason Games:
 - If a game is stopped (weather or other reason), it resumes the next day from the point of interruption during the State Series
 - If one team refuses to return, the score and outcome are final at the point of suspension
 - If the clock was running due to the Mercy Rule, the game is considered complete

16. Determine the length of halftime intermission.

o 6 minutes (can be shortened or lengthened by mutual agreement of both coaches and tournament administration)

17. Determine when the coin toss is to be held.

o No less than 5 minutes prior to game time

18. Authorize the use of TV/radio time-out.

○ **No** – Only if needed at the State Championships

19. Establish rules regarding place kicking for field goals.

o No

Uniform Implementation Timeline

Target Year: for compliance with NFHS 2030

Jersey Color for Visiting Teams NFHS 1-5-1-2a

- NFHS requires white jerseys
- IHSA allows light colors (gray, off-white, yellow, etc.)
- Encourage new jersey purchases to be white for visitors
- Required 2030

Bottoms (Pants, Shorts, Skirts) NFHS 1-5-1-3d

- Must be a **solid color (no stripes)** contrasting with the flag
- Teams with existing striped uniforms may continue using them until 2030 when solid short/pants/skirts will be required
- Flags must not match shorts or stripe color

Flags 1-5-1-3f

- Currently using two-flag belts
- NFHS testing three-flag belts

- Recommend waiting at least 3 years with 2 flag belts before any switch
 Reevaluate after 2028 season
