By-Law Breakdown 3.110 Coaching School Participation

A coaching school, camp or clinic is defined as any program, sponsored by an organization or individual, that provides instruction in sports theory and/or skills. These programs do not culminate in competition. By-law 3.110 and its subsections define the involvement of member school coaches and participation of students at coaching schools.

During the school year, a member school coach cannot be involved with a coaching school, camp or clinic that is attended by more than two (2) students from their school (By-law 3.111). When a member school coach is not involved, any number of students from the school can participate in the coaching school, camp or clinic (By-law 3.112.2).

For example, five (5) students from an IHSA member school could attend a baseball instructional program together during the school year as long as no coach from their school is involved. If a school coach is involved, no more than two (2) students from that school could participate in this program.

Per By-law 3.112, participation in coaching schools, camps or clinics during the summer are permitted between the last day of student attendance at the school and Sunday of Week 5 in the IHSA calendar. Any number of students from a school may attend a coaching school during this time period. Note that if a member school coach is investigation. member school coach is involved, each day of the coaching school would count as a summer contact day for that sport.
