

Tip of the Month

Match the wobble of your crank-bait to the clarity of the water. Remember that when you are fishing dingy water, you need to send out as much vibration as possible so that the bass can locate your bait. Dirty water can also be ideal when you want a crank to rattle. In clear water, a tight wobble and no rattle is usually preferred.

The Spartan fishing team went to the Northern Illinois Hunting and Fishing Days on September 26, 2009 at Silver Springs State Park near Yorkville, IL. As soon as we arrived we noticed all the vendors.

As soon as we got off the bus, most of us headed to the pond that was stocked with bluegill by the Illinois Department of Natural Resources. The Spartans fished there for about 20 minutes and we caught a handful of bluegill. While we were doing that, Matt Jensen decided to learn about fly fishing and how to cast with a fly rod. Matt took some lessons from a guy with the Illinois Smallmouth Alliance. When most of us were done fishing, there was a hunting dog seminar that we attended. We learned how dogs smell pheasant and find them in the fields.

Chris Elliot bought some jerky, but it was not normal beef jerky, it was boar and elk jerky! There were other people demonstrating hunting and fishing techniques and there were also historical reenactments. They also had demonstrations on how to cast 100-150 yards. Casting and fishing demos were taught by Cary Gelfond about basic fishing for catfish and musky.

After that, we went to a giant fish tank that was used for another demonstration. The tank was filled with many giant bass, crappie, carp, drum, catfish, and a musky. All of the fish were shocked from the Fox River and

put in the tank. They also had many other activities such as rock climbing, a casting area, dog training, and more hands on activities for all ages! These Northern Illinois Celebration of National Hunting and Fishing Days are always celebrated on the fourth weekend in the month of September. The Spartans had a really good time and we hope to go back next year.


