TERMS & CONDITIONS RECOMMENDATIONS

1. Item IX. Tournament Policies G. Artificial Noisemakers (new)

Recommendation: Spectators are allowed to use artificial noisemakers if the host school administration approves. Artificial noisemakers may not be used to distract players or umpires.

Rationale: When spectators responsibly use artificial noisemakers to encourage players and celebrate positive plays, it adds excitement to the overall atmosphere of the game.

ADMINISTRATIVE RECOMMENDATION / STATE ASSOCIATION ADOPTION:

Recommendation: All regular season and postseason games will use the following run rules.

- 15-run rule after 3 innings
- 12-run rule after 4 innings
- 10-run rule after 5 innings

Rationale: Using these run rules in all games will allow teams to conserve pitches that their pitchers throw.
