ITEMS OF DISCUSSION:

- 1. The committee discussed details about the spring season currently planned for February, March, and April, 2021.
- 2. The committee discussed concerns about a spring season and the potential timeline to get equipment reconditioned and returned in time to use during summer contact days and in the next football season that starts in August.
- 3. The committee discussed thoughts about the number of games that would justify a spring season if schools aren't able to play the nine-week season that is currently proposed. The committee feels that a minimum of four games would justify a season, even if the season must be moved later in the spring.
- 4. The committee discussed potentially overlapping football with other sports' seasons in the spring. The committee feels that overlapping with baseball, track & field, and wrestling on the back end of the football season is a better option for students than overlapping with basketball on the front end of the football season.
- 5. The committee discussed the IHSA board of director's decision to modify by-law 3.022 that will require students to pass at least 15 credit hours (three classes) from the first semester of the 2020-21 school year in order to be eligible for the second semester of the 2020-21 school year. The committee supports this decision.
- 6. The committee discussed the variety of academic formats schools have used so far this school year.
- 7. The committee discussed the recent IHSFCA virtual coaches' clinic.
- 8. The committee discussed the importance of submitting officials' ratings after every varsity game.
- 9. The committee recognized outgoing members Joe Ryan, Sycamore and Gary Carter, Murphysboro.
