Tournament Procedure Reminders:

- On Friday, you must go into Chesscalate and check your team in by 12:30pm (but please do it earlier). If you fail to check in, your team will not be paired.
- Because we need to send your opponents' Lichess usernames when we make the pairings, we need to know your lineup in advance. That may affect your strategy, since you'll have to pick a lineup BEFORE you know who you're playing (except for Round 4, the first round on Saturday). The deadline for designating your lineup is 30 minutes before the posted start of each round. If you don't designate a lineup by the deadline, your standard lineup (the top 8 players in strength order) must play.
- You must report (or confirm) results using Chesscalate. Please do so as each individual match is completed. If you don't report the results, we have no way of knowing what happened!

• If you have time at the start of each round, you can help us by inputting the Lichess URLs of the eight games your team is playing. This will be easier to do if you use a mouse with your device. You'll find instructions by choosing "Submit links to games" on the Chesscalate menu.

Miscellaneous Reminders:

- The only changes allowed in Chesscalate at this time are changes to your lineup. This means you can only edit which players will be competing in the first round. You can not update your strength order. You can not update the players that are in your final roster of 12. You can only set your Round 1 lineup from the roster of 12 you have already established.
- If a player's account is flagged but still operational, it is up to the discretion of the coach if they will allow the student to participate. However, if LiChess takes action and the player's account is banned during the tournament, that player will not be able to participate after they are banned and will be ineligible for the remainder of the tournament.
