PARKING INFORMATION

Please read the following information carefully and refer to the map of Illinois State University. It is important that you park in the designated areas to avoid being ticketed. Red "Reserved," blue "Accessible" and brown "Business," "Loading," and "Service" spaces and meters are enforced 24/7. You will be ticketed. If you have an accessible permit you'd like to use on campus, please notify ISU Parking to get it registered. The full parking map is available at: <https://bit.ly/2IC0xrr>

- Buses and school vans should enter the ISU campus via University Drive and can unload behind Fell Hall.
- Buses and minibuses may park in the Lot G04 located just North of the McDonald's at the corner of Main and University St.
- Vans and visitors may park in the Visitor's deck on South University St. Vehicles that exit the garage before 4:30pm Friday will be charged \$1/hr; vehicles that exit after the gates open at 4:30pm Friday will not be charged. All parking is open on Saturday so any red or green lot is free to use. We recommend Lot F43, G34 and the South University Deck to be closest to Schroeder, Fell and SFHOB, and F26 and F27 to be closest to Stevenson.

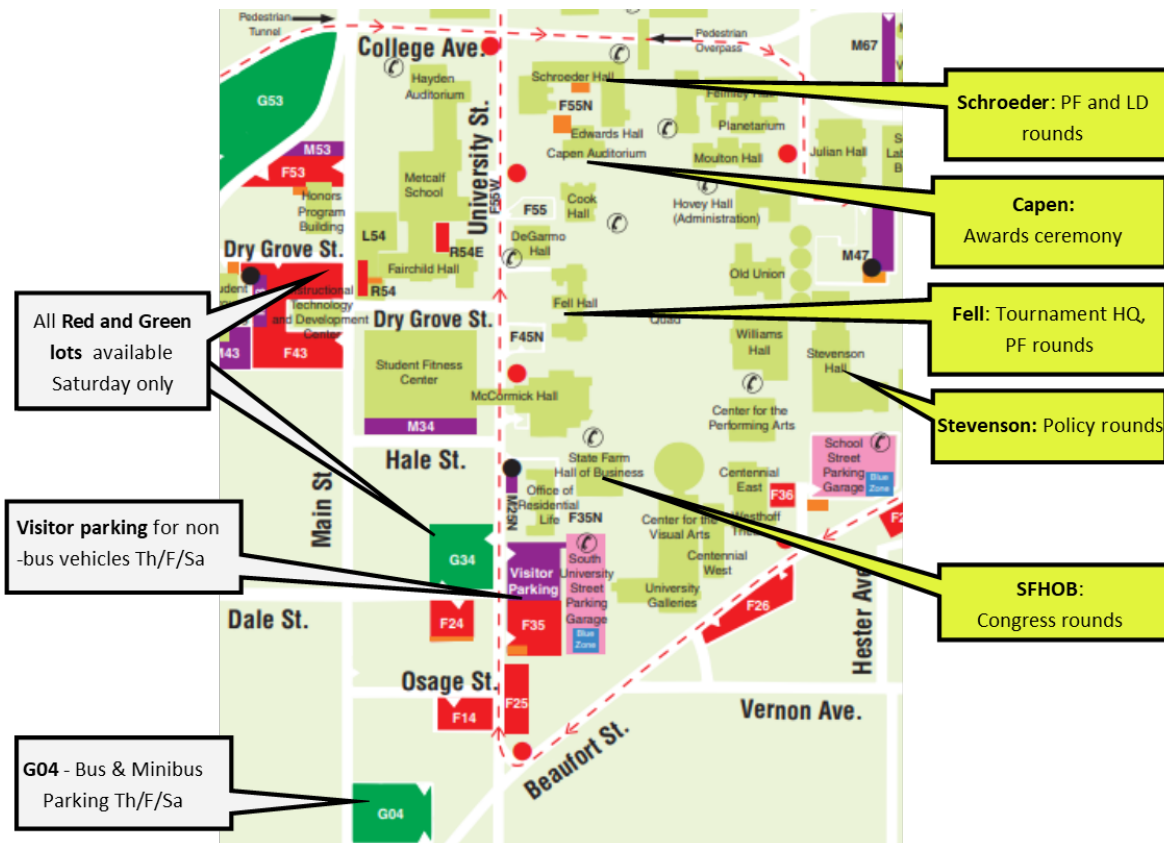

Directions from the Interstates to Illinois State University

Bloomington-Normal sits at the intersection of Interstates 39, 74 and 55, and the Illinois State campus is just down Main St. from the onramp. If using a GPS device, the address for Fell Hall is **304 S. University St Normal IL.**

From I-74 Eastbound

- Merge onto I-55 via exit #127 on the left-toward Chicago
- Take US-51-BR exit (#165A) toward Bloomington-Normal
- Stay straight to go onto US-51 BR/N Main St.
- Turn left on College Ave.
- Take the first right on University St.
- Fell Hall is on the left side of the street at the Rec Center overpass.

From I-74 Westbound

- Follow I-55 towards Chicago
- Take US-51-BR exit (#165A) toward Bloomington-Normal
- Stay straight to go onto US-51 BR/N Main St.
- Turn left on College Ave.
- Take the first right on University St.
- Fell Hall is on the left side of the street at the Rec Center overpass.

From I-55 Southbound

- Take US-51-BR exit (#165) toward Bloomington-Normal
- Turn left onto US-51 BR/N Main St.
- Turn left on College Ave.
- Take the first right on University St.
- Fell Hall is on the left side of the street at the Rec Center overpass.

From I-55 Northbound

- Take US-51-BR exit (#165A) toward Bloomington-Normal
- Stay straight to go onto US-51 BR/N Main St.
