Discussion Items:

- 1. The committee discussed modifying the penalty for Coach/Adult Personnel ejections. The discussion centered around using a percentage of the sport season. Some ideas include:
 - a. First Offense: 1 game suspension.
 - b. Second Offense: 3 game suspension, no contact (including practice) and education (watch the free NFHS Sportsmanship Course). (Note: School Administrators must receive the NFHS certificate of completion from the coach or school personnel upon completion before the individual resumes participation.)
 - c. Second Offense: One third of the season game suspension, no contact (including practice) with the opportunity to reduce to 25% of the season upon completion of sportsmanship education (i.e. watch the free NFHS Sportsmanship Course) and submission of a plan. (Note: School Administrators must receive the NFHS certificate of completion from the coach or school personnel before the individual resumes participation.)
 - d. Third Offense: Season suspension
- 2. Should an education piece be included with the first offense or is the meeting between the coach and administrator sufficient?
- 3. Local control and planning are imperative prior to each contest.
- 4. Committee discussed the importance of the coaches and adult personnel from each sport having the same "ejection" consequences.
